- Exec. Board met on November 2nd and discussed the upcoming installation dinner; the chapter will cover the \$30.00 cost for all the committee chairs, but, it will not cover for spouses, or friends.

- Wall Bracing Seminar will be on December 7th, 2010.
- Sprinkler training that is available can be focused on either the 2007 or 2010 CBC and would probably be better to go over the 2010 CBC requirements at this point; will be looking into setting training up next year.

e. **Electrical:** [Chair: Nancy Martinez]

- The committee met on November 4th, 2010.
- Bruce Barnes of SDG&E provided a copy of a single line diagram of how meter will be installed on the outside wall, and some homeowners have already said they didn't want the extra equipment on the side of the house.
- The vehicle charging electrical will need to be calculated as a continuous load since they will need to charge for over three hours.
- A roof mounted wind turbine that was installed in Lakeside has received an approved field evaluation; it was a modification of a prototype unit that was installed earlier in San Marcos (it was pointed out that these units are not counted as solar even with the small solar panel on the unit due to it doesn't contribute to generating any power for the house).
- There is a new Lennox air conditioning unit on the market now that utilizes a direct connection to PV modules.

g. **Plumbing / Mechanical:** [Chair: Patrick Healy]

- The Committee met on November 3rd, 2010 at the EsGil office building.

- It was mentioned that in Nevada area approximately 95% of the residential sprinkler systems are considered combination type, but they are not a true combination type; Dan Pavao mentioned he heard the thought there was they wanted to make as easy as possible to get water on fires.
- The Plumbing Committee has been trying to get a hold of companies that install Epoxy lining in pipe, but has not contacted anyone yet; some of the listings for epoxy have been pulled.
- ICC does not sell the Model Uniform Plumbing and Mechanical Codes, but, does sell the CA codes.
